Frequently Asked Questions About Certification

I heard that PD certificates for webinars are not eligible for my renewal. What do I need to submit? To ensure that a webinar will be eligible for PD hours, the following two emails have to be printed and saved as documentation: participant's registration confirmation email and the "thank-you" for participating email that is sent after the webinar. Sometimes a webinar will issue PD certificate, we do not accept them as original PD documentation.

Some of the webinars that I am interested are offered during my work hours. What can I do? If you are not able to watch the webinar after registering because of the time of day or for other reasons some organizations will send a "sorry you missed the webinar" e-mail that includes a link to the webinar recording. In order to have a recorded webinar be counted as PD you are still required to register for the webinar and print the registration confirmation e-mail, along with printing the "sorry you missed the event" e-mail and then print the PD certificate that is available after watching the recording (it is the only time we accept a webinar PD certificate).

Why you are not accepting the PD certificates for webinars?

The reason for not accepting the PD certificate on its own is because it is a blank template where you type in or write in your own name and in the past people have used it to provide PD to other people who have not viewed the webinar.
