Frequently Asked Questions About Certification

I have received my certification from the Association of Early Childhood Educators of Newfoundland & Labrador (AECENL) office does that means that I am an AECENL member?

No, when you receive your Child Care Services Certification you are not an automatic member of AECENL. Certification and AECENL membership are separate. The AECENL membership form can be found on our website www.aecenl.ca.

AECENL is the professional association for Early Childhood Educators of Newfoundland & Labrador. The association has a service agreement with the Provincial Government to deliver Child Care Services Certification and Orientation Courses.

The AECENL membership is done on an annual basis. When you become an AECENL member you also become a member of the Canadian Child Care Federation (CCCF) automatically. There are many other direct benefits to being a member:
