Bursaries and Grants - you could qualify!

AECENL, (with the Dept. of Education), offers 3 Bursaries and 1 Grant.

The ECE Trainee Bursary - is designed to support ECE's working in a licensed Child Care Centre/regulated Family Child Care in NL who are taking ECE certificate courses online from a provincially recognized college/university to upgrade their valid Trainee Level Certification.

- \$250 per each successfully completed course
- Now accepting and processing applications received in real time

The ECE On-Campus Field Placement Bursary - helps reduce financial barriers by assisting College of the North Atlantic ECE students who have successfully completed a required on-campus field placement as a part of the ECE distance education program. In return, bursary recipients commit to work in a regulated child care service in NL for 3 years after graduation. Applicants must apply within 6 months of successful completion of the on-campus field placement.

- \$835 per week, up to a total of \$2,500

The ECE Graduate Bursary - to assist ECE's who have obtained a Diploma in ECE through a recognized post-secondary institution in NL. **The ECE Graduate Bursary is ending on June 30, 2024.** Applicants must graduate on or before June 30, 2024 and apply within 6 months of graduation.

- Up to \$7,500

The ECE Recruitment and Retention Grant is to provide funding to recruit and retain Level I to Level IV Early Childhood Educators. The grant includes a commitment for recipients to work in a regulated Child Care Service in NL.

- \$2,500 initial and each 3 year renewal, up to a total of \$7,500
